What is One Source?

Multi-year business transformation project

 Replace many legacy administrative systems and associated business processes

 Next Generation Finance and Human Resource administrative systems and processes: Oracle PeopleSoft 9.2

Why undertake OneSource Project?

- Aging Systems Core systems were designed <u>decades ago</u> with the purpose of satisfying the core processing and reporting requirements of the institution
- Unsustainable Modifying these core systems when possible and implementing ad-hoc vendor provided systems to augment current system capabilities is no longer a sustainable practice or an efficient approach
- UGA is ready Collegiate Project Services survey, interviews, and focus group sessions clearly identified that <u>Colleges and Units need</u> updated and efficient functionality, improved data access, and reporting






Sample of other UGA systems that will be integrated with new PS systems: Works®, UGAmart, eResearch Portal, AiM, iPAWs, Athena

OneSource Project Timeline




UGA's OneSource Roadmap

- Finance

 - Defining Effort Reporting solutions


Planned Project Activity: Spring 2017


