




# Zoom Meeting Authentication

## Joining Zoom Meetings that Require Authentication

This document provides a quick look at how to authenticate your credentials for a zoom meeting.

### Security Requirements

- UGA requires that any Zoom meetings use one of three security options:
  - Waiting Room, Pass Code or Authentication via Single Sign-On (SSO). SSO is the easiest option.




The screenshot shows the Zoom Security settings interface. Under the 'Security' heading, there are three options:

### Single Sign-On Authentication

1. Click on the Zoom meeting link OR navigate to [uga.zoom.us](https://uga.zoom.us), click “Join Meeting” and enter the Meeting ID.
2. From sign in options, choose Sign In with SSO.
